This includes concealing design elements to create a clean look and implementing minimalistic elements like clean surfaces, handle-less or integrated hardware, and clean lines. "Simplicity allows the kitchen to function more efficiently," adds Krista.

Krista also discovered that workstations within the kitchen and other areas of the home are being personalized. "Clients are including specialty food workstations, like pizza-making areas in the kitchen (including outdoor kitchens), coffee stations with specialty built-in coffee makers, baking stations with specialty storage solutions, variable counter heights, and mixer cabinets," notes Krista. "Plus, adjustable islands will give home cooks more options; bar heights, for example, also will be adjustable so that a guest or a family member can lean comfortably while enjoying a glass of wine."

And the wine will be easily accessible, she says. "Wine stations, specialty built-in wine dispensers, wine storage, stemware storage will be in the kitchen or bar area."
